The Cystic Fibrosis Foundation: The mission of the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation is to assure the development of a means to cure and control cystic fibrosis (CF) and to improve the quality of life for those with the disease. CF is no longer considered exclusively a "childhood" disease, as today people with CF are living into their 30s, 40s and beyond. To fulfill the mission, the CF Foundation provides funding for more than 110 cystic fibrosis care centers and 55 affiliate programs nationwide, including 96 programs for treating adults with CF. CF care centers offer diagnostic services and comprehensive treatment for more than 24,000 patients with CF.

The Justin Sheftel Memorial Fund has donated \$6,250 and was a sponsor for the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. This past year The Justin Sheftel Memorial Fund participated in the Great Strides Walk contributing to Jennifer Weider's Team, a graduate of Parkland High School.

and after school programs to all members of the community ages 8 weeks through 5 years. These programs, which offer flexible enrollment, allow working families peace of mind as they know their children are being not only cared for safely but experiencing enriching age-appropriate activities. The JCC also offers summer camping programs, wellness programs for individuals of all ages, and senior socialization programs.

Over the past four years the JCC has been the recipient of \$20,000 from the Justin Sheftel Memorial Fund used for camping scholarships and funding a baseball program for 7-10 year olds. The funds have touched twenty families who have been able to attend extended day camping programs and ten families whose children have been able to participate in an Allentown City sponsored youth baseball league.
